Theory of change

CYPC will promote children and young people's rights so that individuals, organisations and government will both listen to children and young people and take them into account in all decision-making processes. Children and young people will be able to influence decision making directly through consultation and indirectly by decision makers habitually considering their rights and best interests. Ultimately this will lead to a jurisdiction in which children and young people's rights are enlivened and they are free from discrimination in all its forms.

This change process requires the CYPC office to be:

- ✓ Relevant, safe and accessible to children and young people
 - ✓ A credible and trusted advisor, able to influence others
- ✓A knowledgeable authority, sought out to increase others' capabilities.
